

NOTE: This document does not replace the User Manual. Read the provided User Manual thoroughly before installing and operating the appliance.

**Step 1:** Remove excess cardboard surrounding the arill head.

**Step 2** Once removed, two (2) people lift the surrounding cardboard over the grill and off the pallet. **Step 3**: Remove the black foam pads.

Removing the plastic covering:

# CAUTION: DO NOT CUT PLASTIC COVERING WITH ANY SHARP TOOLS.

This may result in scratching your appliance.

**Step 4.** Carefully remove the plastic covering of your appliance.

**Step 5.** Open up the hood of your grill and remove the following parts and set aside

- Manual
- Grates and Heat Zone Separator Box
- Burner Covers box
- Transformer box

#### ASSEMBLING YOUR GRILL:

Each burner has a metal wire wrapped around it. This is installed for shipping purposes. It can be cut carefully using wire cutters. It is also safe to leave installed. If the burner needs to be removed, the wire tie must be cut. See the image below:



#### **WARMING RACK:**

Your grills warming rack has been secured for shipping purposes. Before using the grill, you must remove any material securing the warming rack in place.

**Step 1:** Locate any material securing the warming rack in place.

**Step 2** Remove the material securing the warming rack to your grill.

**Step 3:** Place the warming rack into position.

Ensure all shipping materials, foam, plastic, and paper are removed from the grill before operating.

It is recommended that you install your grill into application (grill base or island) BEFORE adding burner covers, heat zone separators, and grates.

#### **INSTALLATION SETUP:**

**Step 1.** Remove the retaining bracket attaching your grill to the wood pallet by unscrewing them on each side. Discard screws and brackets.



Step 2. With two (2) or more persons, remove the grill from the pallet and partially slide it into the grill base or island cutout. Make sure to lift the grill with one hand on the rear hood opening and one on the bullnose of the grill. With one (1) person bracing the front of the grill, stop short of sliding it in all the way. The gap in the back will allow you to connect the white light wire to the black transformer (see "HOOKING UP THE TRANSFORMER").

**Step 3.** Hook up the gas line. IMPORTANT: Refer to the GAS REQUIREMENTS section in the provided User Manual.

**Step 4.** Continue sliding the grill into place. NOTE: for installation on a grill base, the flange of the grill will drop up and over the cart base, ensuring it is securely fastened; for installation in an island cutout, the grill flange will rest on top of the counter.

## HOOKING UP THE TRANSFORMER:

Step 1. Unbox the transformer.

**Step 2.** Carefully remove the tie closest to the connector shown below in **red**. DO NOT cut any of the other zip ties that are attached to the wire that sits behind the grill.



**Step 3.** Before plugging the three-prong cord into your electrical outlet. Plug the light wire into the transformer.



**Step 4.** Once plugged in, screw in and hand-tighten the connection cover.



# UNBOXING BURNER COVERS / BRIQUETTES, HEAT ZONE SEPARATORS, AND GRATES

**Step 1:** Carefully unbox burner covers. **WARNING:** When handling any stainless steel be aware of sharp edges.

**Step 2.** Place burner covers or briquettes inside the grill over the burners one at a time.



**Step 3.** Remove the cooking grates and heat zone separators from the box. Set heat zone separators to the side.



**Step 4.** Place the cooking grates inside of the grill over burner covers one at a time. Install grates with the square grate lifting opening to the front of the grill.

**Step 5.** Install heat zone separators in between each burner one at a time. It is easiest to install heat zone separators after placing grates in one at a time, as shown in the image.
